TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Being accepted as a scholarship student means that the student will be able to take fifteen (15) free half-hour lessons at A Street Music between January 14, 2013 and May 25, 2013. Only students under the age of eighteen (18) are eligible for this scholarship. Our teachers reserve the right to refuse service. Lessons may be monitored by video or audio recording. Interviews with students for A Street Music’s assessment program will also be recorded. Students are responsible for all materials required by instructors for lessons. Submission of this application is not a guarantee to receive financial assistance scholarship from A Street Music. If the applicant gave false information in this application, A Street Music reserves the right to declare applicant ineligible to receive the financial assistance scholarship and to seek reimbursement of any lesson provided for free before the applicant became ineligible.

CANCELLATIONS

A Street Music must be contacted by phone during business hours at least 24 hours in advance of a reservation, with the exception of situations deemed to be emergencies by A Street Music. If we are not contacted in this fashion, the student will lose one of his/her scholarship lessons. If more than two lessons are missed without proper notice, the student will lose his/her scholarship. Students in emergency situations or who contact A Street Music 24 hours in advance must reschedule the lesson at the instructor’s convenience. Teachers who cancel reservations must reschedule lessons at the convenience of the students.
